International Activity Patch



International Activity Patch **number 00144**-PICTURED ABOVE-This is a temporary emblem worn centered on the right pocket of the uniform shirt.

International Neckerchief **number 00746**

International Neckerchief Slide **number ID-170** to be worn with neckerchief

International Jacket Patch **number 00145** The 5-inch emblem is worn centered on the back of any official uniform jacket.

Who May Earn the patch or items listed above: Available to youth and adult members of the Boy Scouts of America

Requirements: Participate while in the Scouting program in a meaningful exchange of at least one hour with a youth or adult member from another country. The individual from another country can either be currently involved or has been involved in the past.

OR

Visit another country and participate in a Scouting function.

Submission requirements: Submit name, position in Scouting, unit number and type of unit to the Council service center with a sheet indicating how the requirements were met. This may consist of a very short paragraph. The submission must include the signature of the unit leader attesting to their agreement with this award.

Recognitions are available through the Council Service Center.

World Crest Emblem is a 1 1/2 inch purple emblem worn permanently by all Scouts and Scouters to symbolize their membership in the World Scouting Movement. The emblem is worn centered horizontally over the left pocket and vertically between the left shoulder seam and the top of the pocket. **Number 00143.**
